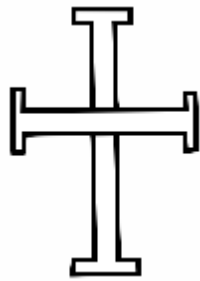
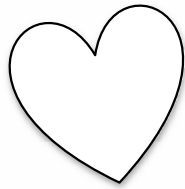

Did you know that God has given us seven ways to celebrate his love?



These celebrations are called sacraments. God gives us his grace through the sacraments. They help us celebrate that we share in Jesus' new



life. The seven sacraments are Baptism, Confirmation, Eucharist, Reconciliation, Anointing of the Sick, Holy Orders and Matrimony.



# Baptism



Baptism is the first sacrament that we receive. It welcomes us into the Church. At Baptism, we receive the Holy Spirit. We are baptized with water. Water is a sign that Jesus shares his new life with us.

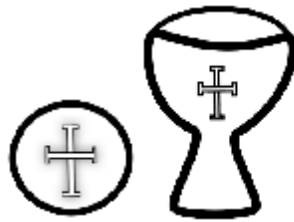
# Confirmation



Confirmation is the sacrament of the Holy Spirit. In Confirmation, we receive the Holy Spirit in a special way. The Holy Spirit helps us share the good news about Jesus.

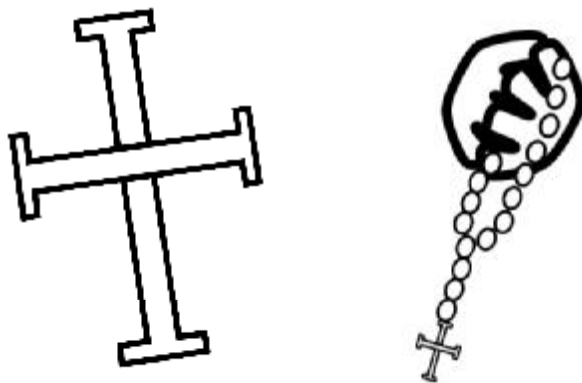
# Eucharist



Eucharist is the sacrament in which we share a special meal with Jesus. The Eucharist, a sacrifice, is God's gift to us. When we celebrate the Eucharist at Mass, we remember that Jesus loves us. Jesus saves us from sin and gives us everlasting life. We thank God for giving us the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ to make his people.

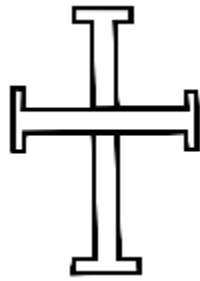
# Reconciliation



Reconciliation is the sacrament that celebrates the gift of God's forgiveness. It also celebrates the gift of God's love for us. We say we are sorry for our sins. We promise to turn away from sin. God always forgives us.

# Anointing of the Sick



Anointing of the Sick is a sacrament of healing. It is the sacrament of Jesus' peace and forgiveness. People who are sick or elderly receive this sacrament.

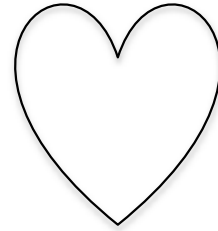
# Holy Orders



The sacrament of Holy Orders celebrates priests, deacons, and bishops. These people are called by God to do Jesus' work in the Church.
